RE: Most Distinguished Alumni, Most Outstanding Undergraduate and C. Rodger Wilson Nominations

The North Central Province Achievement and Awards Committee is requesting each chapter to submit nominations for the **MOST DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI** and **MOST OUTSTANDING UNDERGRADUATE** of the North Central Province. Alumni Chapters should also submit one name for the **C. RODGER WILSON ACHIEVEMENT AND HUMAN RIGHTS AWARD**.

The selection process for the recipients will be as follows:

Only such persons shall be considered for the Awards as are determined to be eligible for candidacy in accordance with the following criteria:

1. A candidate must be in good standing with his college/university and the Fraternity (Grand Chapter, Province, Undergraduate or Alumni Chapter or Association).
2. A candidate's character must reflect credibility upon himself, his college/university (if currently a student), and the Fraternity. *If currently a student, an official college transcript must accompany the petition to be considered.*
3. The achievement, which is the basis of his candidacy, must be of outstanding merit.
4. A candidate should have manifested interest in the Fraternity beyond the payment of dues and assessments.

Each chapter should submit an **original petition plus five (5) copies** of their nominee's petition. Nominations must be typed.

Deadline for submitting petitions is April 1, 2016. The petition must include five (5) copies for consideration. Send all petitions to:

No petition will be considered if postmarked after the April 1, 2016 deadline.

Regulations and Procedures

SECTION I: Petitions for the Awards of the North Central Province of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. are to be submitted with an **original petition plus five (5) copies**. These copies are to be forwarded to the Chairman of the Achievement and Awards Committee. The petitioner should retain a copy.

SECTION II: If the member is in good standing with the Fraternity, as certified by his Polemarch, Keeper of Records, and Keeper of Exchequer, the petition is then forwarded to the members of the Achievement and Awards Committee.

SECTION III: The Chairman of the Achievement and Awards Committee will critically review and investigate the petition for completeness, conformity, and established procedure and accuracy of statement.

SECTION IV: Upon review of the voted petitions received from the Committee Members, the Chairman of the Achievement and Awards Committee will tally all votes and determine the favorable petitioner.
